AMENDMENT TO BY-LAWS

The Board of Trustees has unanimously voted to amend Article V Section 2 to read as follows:

Dues - With the exception of young professionals referred to below, Membership dues include the cost of meals. All members shall pay the assessment for meals regardless of whether they are present at the meeting. The amount of dues shall be determined by the Board and shall be payable quarterly on the first day of January, April, July and October.

Young professionals under the age of 36 shall be entitled to a 50% reduction in the cost of meals.
