The Hon. Judge Raymond Eubanks told us about Success Stories in the Adult Drug Court Program. The program offers an alternative for nonviolent offenders who commit crimes to support their addictions to alcohol or drugs. Participants plead guilty to their charge in court and receive a suspended prison sentence that is satisfied by the completion of a program that includes bi-weekly court appearances, drug screens, treatment sessions and support group meetings. Drug Court lasts a minimum of 14 months, but participants may remain in the program longer in order to meet all requirements.
