She describes her school experiences in level - "Términale ES (translation: senior class with a concentration in economic sciences.) It is of course, really difficult with it being in French and all, but I've been able to follow some classes pretty well, and the people in my new and old classes have been so nice and helpful.

This past weekend was our second RYE (Rotary Youth Exchange) gathering- this time with multiple districts from all over France. There were 250 students from all over the world all together- it was incredible! Saturday morning we all walked around in the quicksand/ mud surrounding the Mont that is there when the tide is low. Saturday afternoon and evening we listened to the national anthems of all of the different countries that were present, saw some traditional French dancers, and then had a dance ourselves until late Sunday morning! It was really great to meet some students who have been here for 8 months already, namely from Australia and New Zealand, who had lots of great advice to share. I also got to see my friend Jeremy from Greenville who is on exchange near Paris, which was so much fun."
